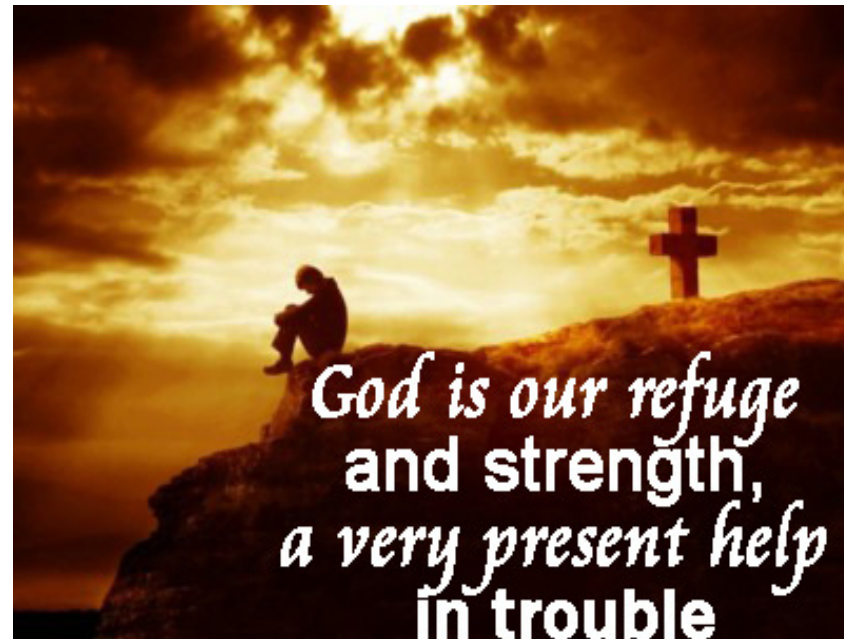

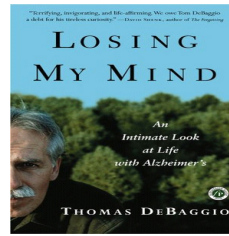


Vacation Bible School Celebration

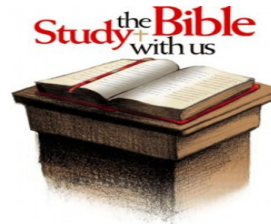

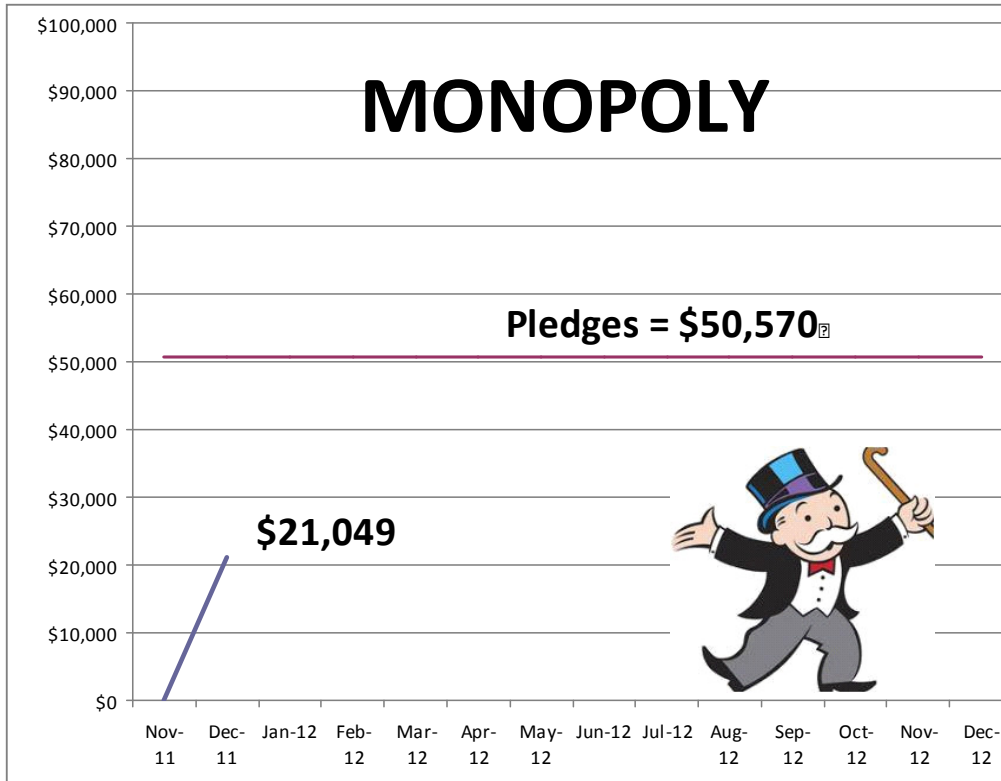

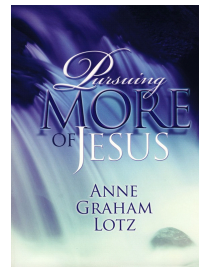
Youth Group Meetings

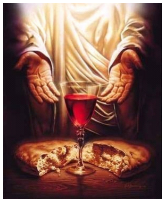
