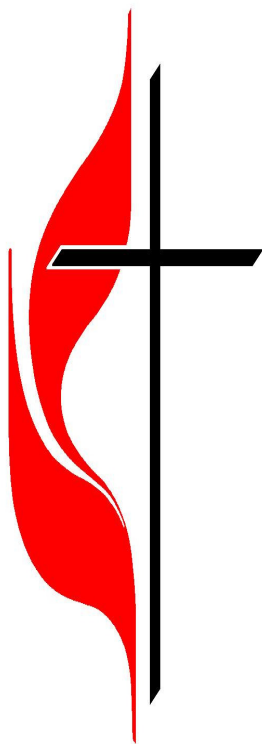
We thank all the help and support from all the volunteers , this would not have been possible without all your help and prayers.

When: August 29th at 10 am.

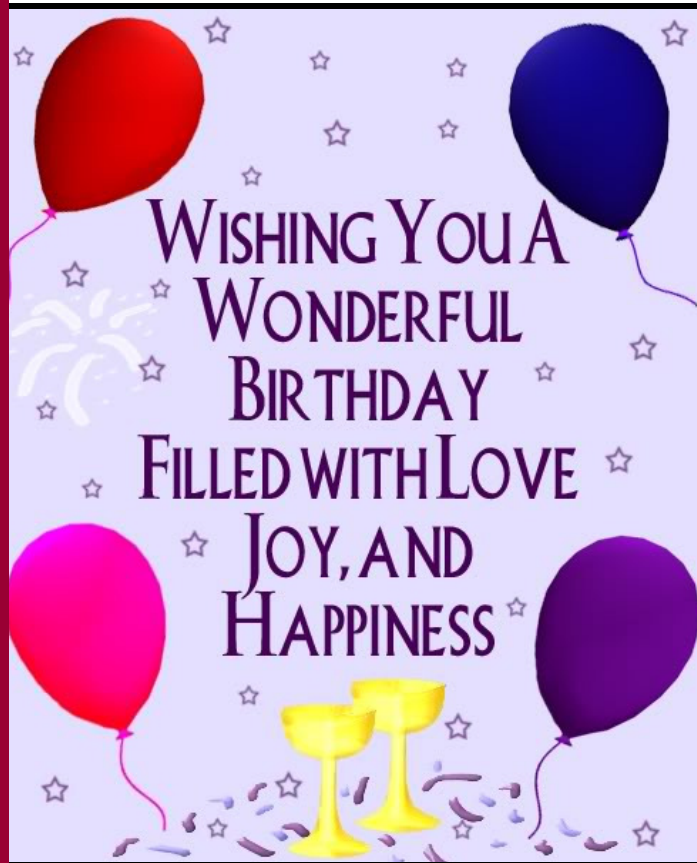
Where: Keizer Rapids Park, Amphitheater.
